



Site Guidelines & Safety

Your Pitch

Please camp within your allocated pitch. Sufficient spacing must be maintained between tents to ensure safe passage and reduce the risk of fire. Leave your pitch as you found it.

Respect Others

Keep noise to a minimum at all times. Quiet hours: 22:00 – 08:00
No disruptive or boisterous games

Facilities & Cleanliness

Please keep toilets, showers and washing areas clean and tidy.
Use designated bins for all rubbish and recycling,
Help us keep the site clean and enjoyable for everyone.

Children

Children must be supervised at all times, particularly near water, play equipment and activity areas.

Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
Please clean up after your pet

Fires & BBQs

Fires are only allowed in designated fire pits (available to hire).
Firewood is available to purchase at reception.
Please do not collect wood from around site to burn.
BBQs must be raised off the ground and supervised at all times
Never leave fires unattended

Looking After the Site

Please respect our surroundings – no damage to trees, plants or facilities
Guests are responsible for any damage caused

Safety & Responsibility

You are responsible for your own belongings
In case of fire, alert a member of staff and call 999.

River / Stream safety

Stay away from marked off area by dam embankment
Do not go near water if in flood
Do not drink stream water

Hygiene

Normal safe hygiene should be adhered to at all times.

Defibrillator

A defibrillator (AED) is located at the entrance to the Lodge as indicated on the site map. Please ask a member of staff for the code.

Acceptance of risk

Camping has elements of unforeseen risk. Anyone wishing to take part in camping at Parkwood Outdoors does so with this understanding.
